Preparation for life's journey

Dear All.

We are looking forward to meeting Key Stage 1 and 2 parents at Open Classrooms next Thursday, 26th September. This is a first opportunity of the year for you to come into your child's classroom, have a look at the environment and the work that has been started. For year 5 and 6 parents, there is also the opportunity to talk to Mr Davies or Mrs Nahajski about the residential trip planned for the spring. The children will be dismissed as usual and then you will be able to come straight into school. There will be a signing in desk on the yard.

Thank you to the parents who came to the coffee morning on Monday- we had a great discussion about many topics, including our priorities for the year ahead. These include:

- Improving how we are teaching reading and writing. We have training programmes this year to refresh how we are teaching Read Write Inc and our new writing programme, Pathways to Write. The Friends have also applied for a very sizeable charity grant to completely overhaul our school library and the books we have on offer to all ages. School results at the end for year 6 are already good in reading, but we want every child to be able to read and write well.
- Looking at making the curriculum even more engaging and creative, particularly in foundation subjects such as history and art and design. This is something we have always done really well but want to extend what we were doing in our old curriculum to our new Cornerstones subjects.
- Making our teaching more consistent throughout the school, so we build on different strategies and means of delivery as children progress through the years. We are using a resource called Teaching Walkthrus to lead us through this.
- Improving outcomes for our children with Special Educational Needs, by making teachers the focal point for the children in their class and continuing with staff training to increase our collective understanding about SEND.

The Friends work very hard on both the events and fundraising sides and are now starting to make a real difference to school at a time when we are facing increasing financial pressures. Our approach is that we respect the different views that parents have about homework but expect that all children will be supported with reading at home and that years 5 and 6 will do homework.

Music tuition

Eric Foster runs several music sessions during and after school.

There is an after-school Guitar Group that is offering half an hour group tuition at a fixed price of £3.50 per head per session for beginners and near beginners for Year 4 and up.

Piano lessons are available for individuals. A 30-minute session is £15 per session; 20 minutes for £10.
